CLIMATE: THE CAPE'S WINEGROWING REGIONS ARE INFLUENCED BY ONE OF THE TWO MIGHTY OCEANS WHICH MEET AT THIS SOUTHERNMOST TIP OF AFRICA: THE ATLANTIC AND THE INDIAN OCEANS. COMBINE BENEFICIAL MARITIME INFLUENCES LIKE REGULAR COASTAL FOG AND COOLING SEA BREEZES WITH A MODERATE MEDITERRANEAN CLIMATE

SOIL: SANDY SOIL, DERIVED FROM TABLE MOUNTAIN SANDSTONE, WITH LOW NUTRIENT AND WATER-RETENTION PROPERTIES.

COLOUR : LIGHT PALE GOLD COLOUR.

BOUQUET: AN AROMATIC WINE, BURSTING WITH PEAR AND QUINCE. THE INTENSE NOSE OFFERS HONEYDEW MELON STONE FRUIT AND CITRUS AROMAS.

TASTE: A WELL-ROUNDED PALATE WITH A GENTLE TEXTURE, THE PEAR AND QUINCE CARRYING THROUGH. THE PALATE IS GENEROUS AND BEAUTIFULLY BALANCED WITH VARIETAL FRUIT FLAVOURS COMPLEMENTED BY PASSION FRUIT NOTES.

ENJOY WITH: PERFECT SERVED CHILLED, EITHER WITH GRILLED SEAFOOD AND SALADS OR BY ITSELF AS AN AFTER WORK TREAT.
